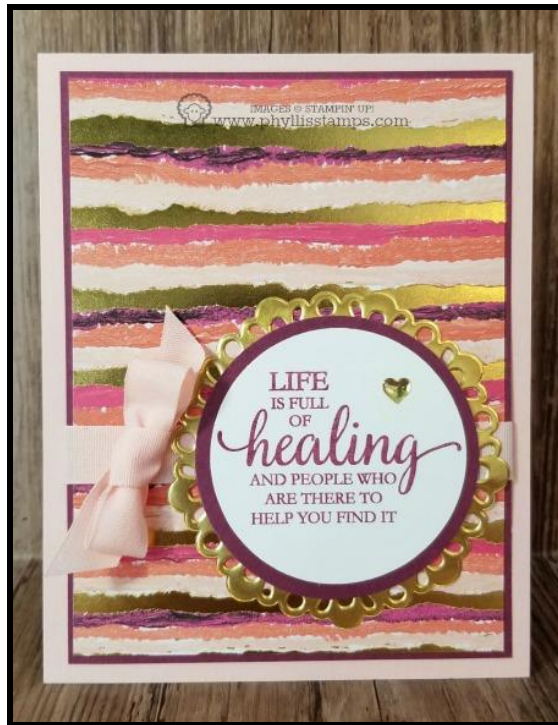

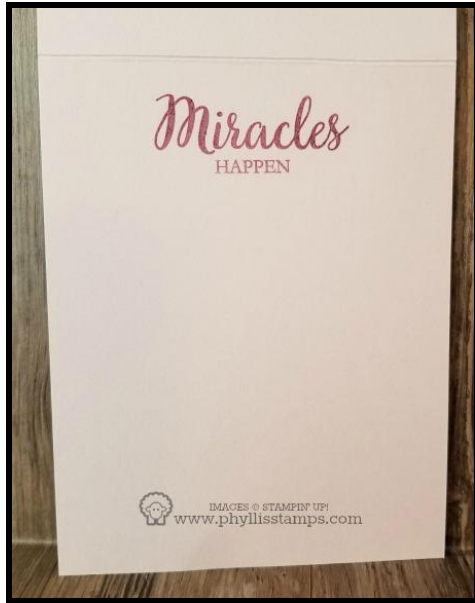

Directions

- *Card Base:* Powder Pink Cardstock – 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- Rich Razzleberry Cardstock mat - 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" + 2 ¼" Circle

- Painted with Love Specialty Designer Series Paper – 3 ¾" x 5", adhere this to the Rich Razzleberry mat
- Cut a 5 ½" piece of ribbon and adhere it around the back of the mat. Adhere this to the card base.
- Whisper White Cardstock – stamp the saying and punch out with the 2" Circle Punch
- Adhere the Metallic Foil Doily, the Rich Razzleberry Circle and the stamped circle. Place a Metallic Enamel Dot on the circle.
- Stamp the saying on the inside



- Tie a bow and adhere it to the strip of ribbon on the front using a Mini Glue Dot
